



How to set up a JustGiving Fundraiser for Cheltenham Animal Shelter

It's really simple to set up a fundraiser with JustGiving. They will guide you through each step to create your own fundraising page which you can share with friends and family to collect donations or sponsorship for your chosen event, in aid of the Shelter.

JustGiving will collect the money on your behalf and forward it to us, along with any Gift Aid which adds 25% tax relief to any eligible donations.

- 1. To get started, visit www.justgiving.com/gawa-cas and click the 'Fundraise for us' button.
- 2. You will need to sign-up if you are not already a member, or login to your existing account.
- 3. Once logged in, you will be given some choices of the type of event that you are raising money for. This could be an occasion, virtual gathering, or other type of event but in this example, we have chosen 'taking part in an event'.
- 4. You can now search for the event to see if JustGiving already has details for it, and if not, you can select 'add your own to continue' to add a new event.
- 5. Complete the required information about your event, or confirm the pre-entered event information is correct, then continue to the next page.
- 6. Set your fundraising target! You can be as ambitious or cautious as you like as we will receive any money pledged to you regardless of the target you set here.
- 7. You will now have the chance to personalise your fundraising page. It is recommended to make your page as individual as possible to get the most donations.
 - I. You can choose the name of your fundraiser which might include your name and the event you are fundraising for i.e. 'Jack's 5k fun-run for Cheltenham Animal Shelter'.
 - II. You can now add a description of your event which should give more details of what you are doing and why you have chosen us as your charity. You can overwrite the pre-filled text or add yours before. We would recommend telling a bit of a story here to help people know why this is important to you i.e. "I am taking on the Cheltenham 5k fun-run dressed as a dog in memory of my beloved Spot, who I adopted from Cheltenham Animal Shelter 10 years ago. They do such wonderful work with unwanted or abandoned pets who have nowhere else to go."
 - III. You can also choose your own URL to make it a bit easier to remember but this is not necessary as you will be able to share this link directly from your page.
- 8. Nearly done! On the next page you will have the chance to add your cover photo and or video. Statistically, pages that feature a photo of the fundraiser receive much more support as it gives people who know you the confidence that they have found the right page. We recommend uploading a photo of yourself or even a short video explaining what you are doing and what peoples' support means to you and to Cheltenham Animal Shelter.
- 9. You can now decide whether you would like to receive information from the Shelter including news, fundraising opportunities, and events.
